RE: Implementation of what has been agreed upon in our meeting on March 5th, 2011

Peace be upon you,

According to what we have agreed in our meeting with the Deans of the Colleges of Technology in your presence on Saturday, March 5th. We would like the following procedures to be implemented in the Colleges of Technology as follows:

1. Authorize the College Councils to allow students who are under academic probation for the 3rd time to repeat the courses that may help them clear their probation.
2. The students should be allowed to be reinstated in the Foundation Program within one year from the date of being debarred; Provided they successfully meet the requirements of this reinstatement and by passing the English language, IT and Math requirements.
3. Students have the right to transfer from the certificate level to the diploma level once they successfully pass the required courses in the certificate level. Students are not granted any certificate at any level unless they successfully pass all courses at that level with a minimum GPA of 2.0 in addition to the completion of the training program.
4. Colleges of Technology shall provide printed teaching materials for the different courses that students study from the concerned college's annual budget.
5. Activate the students' councils at the Colleges of Technology and College Deans are to set up the necessary mechanisms for these councils, and then provide the Ministry with these mechanisms for approval and implementation.

Please take the necessary action and implement what has been agreed on and brief us with your feedback.

Ministerial Decree No. 96/2011

Article Three-This decree takes effect from its date of issue and the concerned parties must implement it.
